- 🔨 Cabinet Installation
- 🔨 Door hanging
- 🔨 Stair Installation

“Interior Systems” Work

- 🔨 Acoustical Ceilings
- 🔨 Metal Studs/Drywall
- 🔨 Access Floor Systems

Where do Carpenters work?

- 🔨 Houses
- 🔨 Office Buildings
- 🔨 Factories
- 🔨 Warehouses

- 🔨 Theaters
- 🔨 Shopping Centers
- 🔨 Schools

Am I Qualified?

- 🔨 Must be at least 18 years of age
- 🔨 Must have a high school diploma or G.E.D.
- 🔨 Must be of good physical condition to perform the work required
- 🔨 Must have a sincere interest in the trade
- 🔨 Must have a valid driver’s license

What can I expect while training?

- 🔨 Program is approximately 4 years
- 🔨 Classroom work and home studies are required
- 🔨 On-the-job Training
- 🔨 Some travel may be required
