What does an Ironworker Do?

- 👉 Erection of structural steel
- 👉 Placement of reinforcing bars in concrete construction
- 👉 Rigging and erection of equipment
- 👉 Installation of miscellaneous fabricated building components
- 👉 Welding fabrication, ornamental, aluminum, sash, brass, bronze and plastic materials
- 👉 Work with metal to close tolerances
- 👉 Machinery moving

Where do Ironworkers Work?

- 👉 Bridges
- 👉 Industrial and commercial buildings
- 👉 Sports stadiums
- 👉 Large residential buildings

Am I Qualified?

- 👉 Must be at least 18 years of age
- 👉 Must have a high school diploma or G.E.D.
- 👉 Must be of good physical condition to perform the work required
- 👉 Must have a sincere interest in the trade
- 👉 Must be willing to work in extreme heat and confined spaces

What can I expect while training?

- 👉 Program is approximately 4 years
- 👉 You must pass a preliminary test
- 👉 On-the-job Training with an experienced Journeyman
- 👉 Some travel may be required
